

Message from the Veep

December 2017

Vice President Forrest Roberts

Well Sunbursters, for most of us November brings the end of Corvette driving season. Some of you may drive your cars south, others may convert to all-season or winter tires. If you have summer-only rated tires, you are advised not to drive below 40 degrees as the sidewalls will not flex properly and this may cause sidewall cracking or reduce traction for acceleration/braking. Most of us will store our Corvettes until spring in our own garage or a storage facility. I thought for the benefit of everyone I would share how I prepare and store our car. Others should add tips or additional personal preferences because these are by no means the only storage techniques.

OIL - I store with a fresh oil change. Personally I want any impurities removed from the crankcase. Others say change first thing in the spring. I do both in case condensation occurs over winter. Suffice it to say that I consider an oil change cheap maintenance.

GASOLINE – Add Sta-Bil or another preservative to fresh gasoline. Be certain it has thoroughly mixed in the tank and you've driven sufficiently to circulate the preserved gas throughout the fuel system.

TIRES – I inflate ours to about 40 PSI. Then when the temperature drops and tire pressure is reduced by a few pounds you're fine and if there is a slight leak, you're probably still covered. Also, because I don't lift ours off the floor, any potential springtime flat spot is lessened.

Place something between your tires and concrete. Cement will gradually absorb moisture from rubber, especially when the tires remain on the same spot. So, get some carpet or plywood to separate your tires from the garage floor. There are accessories to drive onto that "cradle" tires – they're costly and the above have worked for me.

BATTERY TENDER – newer cars draw power continually to maintain on-board electronics. Your battery will need periodic charging and a battery tender is an easy solution when you're not driving regularly. An interesting discussion topic earlier this year suggested using a timer to limit battery tender operation to only about an hour per day so as to eliminate any risk of overcharging should the battery tender itself malfunction. Seems like a good suggestion and I'll connect the tender to a timer this season.

WASH THE CAR – you don't want dirt on the paint when positioning your car cover. Lower a window just in case the battery tender fails and you can't unlock the door – this way you can still reach the release lever by the floor to get inside.

STORING – Consider some d-CON or other rodent protection placed strategically around the car. One member inserts dryer sheets into the exhaust pipes. I've never had rodent problems but we've all heard about nests and electrical wire damage.

Connect the battery tender and cover over the car.

Next spring you will uncover a clean car, deflate the tires and celebrate.

For that Special Person with a special car! Build sheets and Window stickers are a must for every Corvette collector.

Build sheets and Window stickers

Your Corvette Collection just isn't complete without a copy of your build sheet and a reproduction window sticker! The National Corvette Museum offers build sheets and window stickers for any Corvette assembled in Bowling Green since the GM Plant opened in 1981.

There's a lot of collectible paperwork associated with cars. Most people throw the stuff out shortly after buying their car but in some cases the original paperwork is still available with the car.

The Build Sheet, often considered "the holy grail", to many folks is a cool item to find. It is often the only means of verifying exactly what options came with your particular car, and helps you determine how many Corvettes were produced exactly like yours. The build sheet is what goes down the line with the car when it is being assembled. It indicates to the line worker exactly what goes on that specific car.

Build sheets vary in size from year to year, 8½ X 11 up to 11 X 17 and you have the option for it to be laminated through the NCM.

Purchase a Build Sheet

Build Sheet (Paper) - \$35 Members* / \$45 Non-Members Additional Paper Copy - \$10 Members* / \$12 Non-Members Lamination - \$5 each

Also called a Monroney Label, this is the sticker that is affixed to a new car when it is delivered to the consumer. A law was passed by Congress in 1958 requiring all automobile manufacturers to affix a price label to all new automobiles showing Manufacturer's Suggested Retail Prices for a vehicle and all options installed at the factory. This law was proposed by Senator John Monroney, and was to begin with new 1959 models.
