Many of us put a battery tender (battery maintainer) on our cars when they aren't being driven for more than a week or so. Unlike a trickle charger that keeps trying to charge your battery forever, a battery maintainer will slowly charge your battery to full, then shut off and wait until the battery runs down just a little, then charge it up again. This keeps your battery always fully charged but never over-charged.

Of course, the maintainer can fail. If it fails completely, then your battery will slowly run down and eventually go dead. That's inconvenient and an abuse of the battery, but not a disaster.

But if the maintainer fails in such a way that it keeps charging forever and never shuts off, that's a real problem. Eventually, it will "cook" your battery and ruin it. Worse than that, it can cause acid leakage that could do serious damage to your car.

Sunburst member Ed Armatys has a good idea- he gets a light timer from the hardware store and plugs his battery maintainer into that, then sets the timer to power the maintainer for only 4 hours per day. That should be plenty to keep your battery charged up, but reduce the chance of over-charging if the maintainer goes haywire.

I would recommend connecting this setup to the car to be sure it works, then unplug the timer for a minute as if your house had lost power. Then plug the timer back in and verify that the maintainer starts working again. Then go enjoy your vacation
