- Saturday and Sunday are both 7 Event Days.
- o Times will be posted, but participants are encouraged to view them via their smartphones.
- Social distancing is suggested in all situations.
- o There is absolutely NO SMOKING OR VAPING ON MCC property.
- o No alcohol or mood modifiers are allowed before, during, or after the event.
- o Racers may be asked to work in order to minimize the number of participants.
- In case of emergency Dial 911. Your location is 8900- US 14, Crystal Lake.
- Please put all waste in the trash container and police your area before leaving.
- Knocked down cones are 2 seconds. Cones must be knocked over or completely moved out of the chalked box to earn that 2 second penalty. Lay down cones count. Hitting the cones at the finish line is a DNF. 2 tires on the grass will constitute a DNF.
- Down Cone Policy:
 - If you encounter a down cone on the course STOP, HONK YOUR HORN and get the attention of a corner worker. Proceed to the finish line. You will get a re-run.
 - If you ignore the cone, you may be charged a 2 second penalty for a down cone.
- Red Flag Stop immediately and wait for directions from a corner worker.
- All pets must be kept on a leash and please clean up after them.
- Northern Illinois Corvette Club owns and operates the timing equipment. Drivers are responsible for damage to the equipment. Hit and you own it. Special thanks to Dale and Carolyn Samuelson.
- Timing and equipment trailers are off limits. Event issues will be handled by Dale Samuelson, Joan Thomas and Mike Stevens.
- Staging Please be ready when your run group is called. Make sure to return to your same lane for the second run in each event.
- Run Order- To be described at the Driver's Meeting.
- o There will be no lunch break
- o In lieu of trophies, a voucher for food will be provided to each racer, for each day of racing.
- Numbers will be assigned by Registration per assigned number list and available numbers.
- All drivers must show a valid drivers license and NCCC members must show a current NCCC card.
- Open exhausts are prohibited.

National Corvette Museum's Motorsports Park To Receive \$2.4 Million In Improvements

The National Corvette Museum announced plans for \$2.4 Million in improvements to the museum's Motorsports Park. In December of 2021, the NCM Motorsports Park was heavily damaged when an EF-3 tornado touched down in Bowling Green. The National Corvette Museum and its board of directors decided to leverage the unfortunate circumstances of the tornado to create opportunity. Instead of simply restoring the Motorsports Park to pre-tornado conditions, the National Corvette Museum is planning significant improvements to the park's facilities.



National Corvette Museum President and CEO Sharon Brawner said of the planned improvements, "The National Corvette Museum, along with our board of directors, looked at the extent of the damage to the Motorsports Park and decided to find the silver lining in a

really difficult circumstance. The improvements we have planned will take our already worldclass racing facility to the next level, including much-needed indoor and outdoor event spaces, bar and restaurant offerings in our track observation areas, and upgraded garage facilities."

The NCM Motorsports Park, which is located on 185 acres of property adjacent to I-65 in Bowling Green, opened in 2014. Designed by legendary race track designer Steve Crawford, the road course was created with input from Corvette Racing, resulting in a multiple, reconfigurable track layout with features from Le Mans. According to Greg Waldron, Executive Director of the NCM Motorsports Park, the planned improvements will allow track participants, observers, and other guests to experience a level of facilities on par with the excellence of the track itself. With the addition of these new amenities and reimagined spaces, the Motorsports Park will be the

foremost racing and karting destination in the Southeast.

The NCM Motorsports Park will remain open during construction, and the project is currently slated for completion by early 2024. Visitors can currently enjoy C8 Corvette driving experiences, track rentals for personal vehicle driving and racing, and high-speed go-karts. The Motorsports Park also offers league racing and group karting in addition to corporate and private events. More information on the NCM Motorsports Park can be found at MotorsportsPark.org.

Air Filters, Part 2

As previously mentioned, I'm lazy and had the dealer change the engine air filter on our 2017, it didn't have many miles but was at the 4 year time limit. When removed, the old filter looked normal and clean at first glance. But when Paul separated the "pleats" in the filter, every one of them had a line of fine sand down at the bottom. This was probably from our recent Colorado trip, where we drove through a couple of quick and "minor" dust storms. Hopefully, all the dust/sand stayed outside the engine.

Continuing with my laziness, I had the cabin air filter changed. When removed, it had a collection of leaves/twigs/dust bunnies like the inside of a vacuum cleaner. Definitely time for replacement.

For you C8 folks, those cars also have an engine air filter and cabin air filter that need occasional replacement.

The car will show you a message when the engine air filter needs to be replaced, the cabin air filter should be changed every two years like other generations.


You can change both of those filters yourself if you wish, but both of them require some minor disassembly to get them out. YouTube is your guide.


