



- Sponsors Page



What If My C7 Gas Door Won't Open?

If the gas door on your C5/C6 won't open normally, there is a small pull tab in the sidewall carpet in the left side of the trunk. Just pull the tab to open the gas door. On the C7 & C8, GM deleted that tab. I don't know about the C8, but for the C7 only:

First, push the Unlock button on your fob a couple of times to be sure the car is unlocked- the gas door will be locked if the people doors are <u>locked</u>, even if they are actually open.

Next, with the driver door unlocked, try pushing in on the gas door several times while pushing the Unlock button on your fob. That takes the pressure off the locking mechanism and may allow it to work if it's weak or dirty. Thump the fender with your hand <u>behind</u> the gas door, that's where the lock is installed.

If that doesn't get the gas door open, there's no need to panic. If you're near your favorite dealer, you can just drive there and let them fix it. Or drive home and make an appointment, or disable the latch (see final paragraph).

If you're in the middle of nowhere, or on a long road trip, you may need to take more drastic action. The method I'm about to explain has been used by several people, but I haven't done it yet myself and there is some possibility of damaging the door. Especially in cold weather, when the plastic is more brittle. Here's the plan:

Take two thin plastic credit cards. Slip them into the gap between the gas door and the fender at about the 10 o'clock position, just behind/above the finger cutout for the driver door. The cards should be "on top of each other"- the inner one will protect the fender and the outer one will protect the gas door. Insert a thin flat-blade screwdriver between the cards, and gently twist. That should pop the gas door off its plastic hinge without damaging anything. Be sure to have a helper ready to catch the gas door when it pops off, so it won't get scratched from falling on the pavement. Buy your gas and drive away.

You can block the gas door lock so you won't have this problem again, some people do it when they buy the car so they can't have a problem later:


The black plastic latch inside the rear edge of the gas door has a hole in it, and the door is locked by a small plunger that jumps into the hole from the rear when the driver door is locked. You can push a plastic "scrivet" (auto parts store) into that lock hole from the back, so the locking plunger can't fit in there to lock the gas door. Eventually the lock plunger may fail but you won't know since it's not doing anything.




