More specific information will be available in the fall.

- In case of emergency Dial 911. Your location is 8900- US 14, Crystal Lake.
- Please put all waste in the trash container and police your area before leaving.
- Knocked down cones are 2 seconds. Cones must be knocked over or completely moved out of the chalked box to earn that 2 second penalty. Lay down cones count. Hitting the cones at the finish line is a DNF. 2 tires on the grass will constitute a DNF.
- o Down Cone Policy:
 - If you encounter a down cone on the course STOP, HONK YOUR HORN and get the attention of a corner worker. Proceed to the finish line. You will get a re-run.
 - If you ignore the cone, you may be charged a 2 second penalty for a down cone.
- Red Flag Stop immediately and wait for directions from a corner worker.
- All pets must be kept on a leash and please clean up after them.
- Northern Illinois Corvette Club owns and operates the timing equipment. Drivers are responsible for damage to the equipment. Hit and you own it. Special thanks to Dale and Carolyn Samuelson.
- Timing and equipment trailers are off limits. Event issues will be handled by Dale Samuelson, Joan Thomas and Mike Stevens.
- Staging Please be ready when your run group is called. Make sure to return to your same lane for the second run in each event.
- o Run Order- To be described at the Driver's Meeting.
- o There will be no lunch break
- o In lieu of trophies, a voucher for food will be provided to each racer, for each day of racing.
- Numbers will be assigned by Registration per assigned number list and available numbers.
 - o All drivers must show a valid drivers license and NCCC members must show a current NCCC card.
- Open exhausts are prohibited.

Air Filters

The C6 and C7 have an air filter for the engine air, and for the cabin air. They are the typical pleated-paper filter, and work better than they look.

Some interesting notes:

The engine air filter works best after it has been used a bit, so changing your filter too often is not a good idea. And it's expensive.

I have our C7 filter changed when getting an oil change a little before the specified filter mileage interval, and there is also a time interval that I follow. Our current engine filter is way short of the specified miles, but due for change according to time. Thanks to Covid.

Changing the engine air filter on a C6 is not a big job, but the C7 is more complicated, look up the instructions before jumping in.

The C6 cabin air filter is an easy change, you just have to carefully wiggle the new one into place without bending or crimping it. The track is curved.

The C7 cabin filter is easy if you have the base car without the dry sump oil system. If you have a Z51/GS/Z06/ZR1, there is an oil line in the way. You can still handle this one yourself, but I don't feel comfortable messing with anything related to the oil system, so I have it by our dealer on this car.

If you haven't changed the cabin filter for a couple of years, you might be surprised at the amount of junk yours has picked up.

Cabin air filters on both cars can be had as a plain filter, or one that's impregnated with charcoal to filter out some odors.

Lucky Friday May 13th, 2022, dawned sunny and warm. Seven Corvettes met in Joliet for a ride along Historic Route 66, heading to Pontiac for the Illinois Chapter of National Corvette Restorers' Society (NCRS) Chapter meet in Pontiac, IL that weekend.

The Road Tour stopped at a few Route 66 establishments, including the Standard Station at Odell, IL (see photo), arriving at our hotel in Pontiac in mid-afternoon. We wound down the day with a lecture on 1953-1955 valve covers, intake and exhaust manifolds. Fun stuff!

The operation checks began on Friday afternoon, with the final "cold start" and Flight Judging (see photo – flashlights and mirrors are part of an NCRS Judge's kit) done on Saturday at the local GM/Chevy dealer. At the end of the Flight Judging, the scorekeepers tallied the point deductions and then made the awards.

My 1993 Anniversary Coupe, "Ruby", was accorded Top Flight with a score of 97.1 out of 100. In total, about eight (8) person-hours were expended on judging my (and any other) car. (More on judging in a minute). This was Ruby's first show, and I am pleased that the car is as original as I thought it was when I bought the 1993 Coupe in 2012.

As an aside, I am an NCRS Judge, just short of my "Master Judge" award. I did NOT judge my own car.

NCRS Flight Judging

From the NCRS Corvette Judging Reference Manual, 9th Edition:

"Judging recognized owners who have preserved or restored their Corvettes to factory original appearance and function."

"Flight awards represent the judgment and opinion of fellow NCRS members...as to the originality, condition and operational function of a Corvette "as is, where is"".

"Cars are to be judged to the standard of the vehicle appearance, and as equipped at the time and point of final assembly by the Chevrolet Motor division.... Presentation for judging is to be in the condition normally associated with that of a Corvette which has undergone the then

current standard Chevrolet Dealer New Car Preparation for delivery to a purchaser, exclusive of any dealer or purchaser inspired additions, deletions or changes."

Scoring is based on a deduct-scoring system, starting with 4500 points and deducting from there. The points are then converted to a percentage based final tally. Awards are giving on the following points:

Top Flight 94% - 100% Second Flight 85%. – 93.9% Third Flight 75% - 84.9%

(Sounds like school, doesn't it? <G>)


Cars are judged on bases of Originality and Condition, with a little kicker for cleanliness. In Flight Judging, four areas are judged: Operations, Interior, Exterior, Chassis and Engine Compartment. NCRS encourages cars to be driving to meets, so they award points base on the miles driven. For my 130 miles (one way), 1.3 points were added to my score of 95.8, bringing my total to 97.1%.
