Message from The Governor

Governor Mike Stevens

December 2022

Happy Holidays, Sunburst Members,

That was one quick year! It seems the older I get the fast time travels. 2022 is almost in our rear view mirror and most of our Vettes have settled down for a long winter's nap. This past year has proven to be relatively successful, from the perspective of NCCC and the Midwest Region. We've seen the return to competitive events and a change in the hierarchy of the region in the "post Covid" year.

In 2022, Sunburst placed 8th out of 25 clubs, in total points awarded for participation and competition, with Mad City Vettes the regional champions. Along with winning the championship, Mad City also won the right to host the Midwest Region Awards Banquet on March 25th, in Madison Wisconsin. More details will follow in January. For individual members, Sunburst Women, **Karen Hottenrott** placed 17th with 281 points. Sunburst Men: **Mike Moushey** 28th – 196 pts, **Jim Downing** 27th – 243pts, **JR Hottenrott** 22nd – 312pts, **Mike Stevens** 19th – 342pts.

One quick follow-up on our October autocross events. Sunburst was able to add almost **\$1400** to our Club's budget from the proceeds of the event. We couldn't have done that without all of the help form our trusty volunteer core. Thank you!

The most important people, at any competitive event are the workers, who make it possible for the events to be run safely and fairly. Workers receiving awards this year (at least 21 events or three days of autocross) are **Leo Casanas, Jack Schneider, Julie Thomas, Dave Thomas and Mike Rosendahl.**

Pat and I attended the National and Regional Governors' meetings in ST. Louis this month. NCCC Governor's elected Deb Murphy, from Florida, as the next NCCC President, succeeding Dale Samuelson. Registration for the 2023 Convention, in Bowling Green, will open in February. The convention will coincide with the Corvette's 75th Anniversary. Watch for information on the NCCC website <corvettesnccc.org>. Your NCCC membership cards will arrive in the mail sometime in February.

At the regional level, Governors re-elected our officers for another term. The most pressing issue on the agenda was the region's finances. For a number of years, the region has been operating with a budget surplus from hosting a convention about 10 years ago. That surplus is gone and focus is on raising revenue, cutting costs and avoiding the dreaded "head tax". Some serious discussions and difficult decisions lie ahead, but changes are inevitable.

Pat and I hope that you and your family have the happiest of holidays. Take time to rekindle old friendship and cherish your time with family and good friends.

Loren asked for a motion to approve the minutes from the October 6 Membership Meeting. Julie Thomas made the motion, Stephanie Doppelt seconded the motion, and the motion unanimously carried.

Officer Reports

<u>President</u> – Loren Doppelt. Loren presented two awards: The Fickle Finger of Fate award to Mike and Priscilla Wilinski who had alternator problems on the Mini-Fall Color Run, and the National Corvette Museum's Third Place trophy for the Club's website to Gary Gembala. Gary will place the trophy in the Club's display case at Martin Chevrolet.

<u>Treasurer</u> – Leo Casanas. Leo indicated that the financials are in good order and indicated that the Board has included a line item of \$1,000 to accrue for the Club's 50th Anniversary.

<u>Governor</u> – Mike Stevens. Mike indicated that the NCCC competition season is over. Sunburst placed eighth out of twenty-five clubs in the Midwest Region. In the women's division, Karen Hottenrott placed 17th out of 135.

Mike and Pat will be going to the Regional and National Governors' meeting in St. Louis next weekend where the final competition schedule for 2023 will be determined.

Standing Committee Reports




Healthy Lombard




