Message from The Governor

Governor Mike Stevens

June, 2022

Greeting Sunburst Members,

Memorial Day weekend is in our rear view mirrors and the summer driving season is here. However, the price of gasoline, especially premium, may keep those summer miles a little lower than normal. Regardless, now is the time to enjoy your Vette.

I attended the MWR, and National governor's meetings in St. Louis last month. Here are a few of the items discussed:

- The 2022 NCCC Convention will be held in Atlantic City N.J in June. The 2023 Convention will be held in Bowling Green and the 2024 Convention will be held in Joplin, MO.
- The MWR has 27 Clubs and is the largest region, by membership, in NCCC.
- Nine \$1500.00 scholarships were awarded to students continuing their education in 2022.
- The Regional Awards for Workers has changed and is now referenced to the number of events worked – 21 events.
- A recommendation was made to change the By-laws so that changes in the competition rulebook could be voted on by individual items as opposed to the all or nothing vote now.

The major theme of both meetings was **SAFETY** at competitive events. In 2022 there were a few serious accidents that happened at competitive events, both NCCC events and non-NCCC events. The resulting insurance claims were significant and, in at least one instance, resulted in the loss of insurance coverage for a Western States Corvette Organization.

The loss of insurance coverage is significant, because our NCCC insurance not only covers our competitive events, but it also protects our officers. Sunburst has been fortunate to never have made a claim, but know that protection is there is important to the well being of our members and especially our officers. We were encouraged to intensify our efforts in providing safe competitive experiences for our participants, workers and spectators.

In August and October, Sunburst will be hosting two autocross events at McHenry County College. Mike Moushey and I will be seeking volunteers to help us run the events. We will be reassessing the locations for our corner workers and intensifying our training efforts so that our workers and competitors will be as safe as possible. The changes may slow things down a little, but that will be worthwhile trade-off.

With Memorial Day in mind, I'd like to thank all of veterans for their service. Keeping America safe so that we can cherish the benefits of a free country is a noble and honorable effort.

This past March, Director of Collections and Senior Curator <u>Derek E. Moore</u> resigned from his position "to take a step back from the rigors of senior leadership responsibilities and spend more quality time with his young family."

After nearly two decades of moving up the ranks in the automotive museum field, Moore took the position of Curator at the Lane Motor Museum in Nashville, where he returned to day-today, hands-on collections work with their expansive and unique collection.

The search for Derek's replacement has concluded and on May 24th the National Corvette Museum announce that Brian Baker has been named Director of Collections & Education. Baker joins the National Corvette Museum team from the Automotive Hall of Fame where he served as Vice President of Education and Principal Historian.

Baker's impressive automotive career spans decades as a General Motors Senior Creative Design Manager and as Vice President of Design and Marketing at American Specialty Cars. With a passion for education, Baker has served as an Adjunct Professor at the Automotive History College for Creative Studies in Detroit, Michigan for over two decades. In addition to his work in corporate automotive design and education, Baker founded AUTOARCHEOLOGY, LLC,

an international Design Consulting Firm, in 2009. Through this company's work, Baker has represented four major automakers as an expert witness in design patent issues.

Baker's depth of knowledge has resulted in him becoming a sought-after expert for the media. In recent years, Baker has served as an assistant producer and on-camera expert for the Discovery Channel and has worked as an automotive historian and analyst for ESPN. He also regularly serves as a writer, editor, and book developer, and he has worked on projects all over the globe including Europe, India, Japan, and South Korea. Baker holds a degree in Transportation Design from the Art Center College of Design in Pasadena, California.

Baker will assume his duties in June.



GMRS Radios

There are three different styles of radio we can use to communicate between cars while on the road: CB, Family Radio, and GMRS.

The most important thing to remember is that all cars in the group must be on the same style of radio. A CB can't talk with a GMRS, etc.

There is a slight intermix between some GMRS and some Family Radio frequencies, but it's complicated and the range is very limited, so don't plan on it.

A GMRS hand-held radio is very convenient, and almost equal to a mounted CB; good enough to talk with cars close to you in the group, but not further. In a convoy of 7 cars, I often could not understand cars at the other end. Frustrating. And the hand-held uses batteries quickly if you are transmitting often- I need to switch batteries part way through the day and then charge them both at night. If you don't talk much, you might get through a day on one battery. I think of my hand-held as something to keep me going until I get a hardwired unit with external antenna.

A hard-wired GMRS with an external antenna works great, but the installation and antenna setup can be complicated, and it costs more. They are so much better than the hand-helds that I plan to get a hard-wire GMRS and figure out a good antenna setup, then keep my hand-held as a backup. Some of the Sunburst members who have done this already can help explain to you.


I'll keep my hard-wired CB and external antenna, in case we get time-travel back to the 1970's. They work pretty well but not many people are using them now.

Family Radio hand-helds are super cheap and convenient, but extremely limited range and can't talk with CB/GMRS, so not very useful for us.


