

PAWS consists of a small group of women who's mission it is to make and sell mittens, which in turn funds wells in Africa. To date we have funded 16 wells, which come at a cost of \$7,500 each and that is an average sale of 200 mittens. Since we started 7 years ago we have made over 3,000 mittens and made \$112,500.00. All of our mittens are handmade using recycled wool or cashmere sweaters that have been donated or purchased at resale stores. We are dedicated to raising as much as we can, using 100% of our profits, and finding the most competent and economical resource to build clean water wells in deeply impoverished areas of the world.



Pioneer Center for Human Services

Pioneer Center provides three pillars of Human Services to the McHenry County community. Our Intellectual & Developmental Disability (IDD) Services programs promote independence by offering life skills, community inclusion, vocational training and residential programs, each striving to help every person live life to their fullest potential. 


Healthy Lombard


