# Letter from the Editor

This year we are celebrating the 45<sup>th</sup> anniversary of Sunburst. This is a copy of the very first newsletter. I hope this little Blast from the Past is a good reminder of how far we've come!!

#### MAY, 1978

This is Sumburst Corvette Club's first attempt at an official newbletter. Due to a limited amount of time to compile articles and a staff of zero on the publication committee (Joan Dietrich is putting this newsletter together as secretary, but only temporarily). this issue is a shortened version of what we hope to print each month.

In future issues we hope to include monthly minutes of the business meeting, N.C.C.C.'s Governor's Report, a full-page calendar of coming events, club activity flyers, a swap page (if you have any Corvette parts to sell or are looking for anything, this will be the place to print it), an explanation of our points system along with current point standings (perhaps every other month), and possibly a page of advertising, including Albert Peter Chevrolet.

SUMBURST CORVETTE CLUB was a year old on March 23, 1978. Its first neeting was held on March 23, 1977, in the basement of the Crystal Lake Police Department. 13 people were present, and all but 2 of them went on to become charter members. As of this date, 9 of these who were present at the first meeting are S.C.C. members. They are: Ton and Jean Adams, Phil and Dort Danneir, Tom and Joan Districh, Charlie Smolarsk, and Chris and Pam Kohlman. Gary and Mancy Klein were hard-working members until they sold their Corvette last fall.

Participants are already raving about the experience. One-on-one student, Spencer C., went from a beginner group student, with one track day under his belt, to a quick and smooth advanced group driver, after only one day working with Andy. Spencer said, **"I had a great time working with Andy. I beat my best time by almost 14 seconds and learned so much in only one day; just amazing value!"** 

One on one coaching participant, Carter S., said, "He is a wealth of knowledge on this topic



and this was evident to me due to the sessions on the track with him, and then debriefing in the classroom after those sessions." Carter said he found the use of the data collected from the track sessions extremely educational because of his explanation of the data, which then improved lap times. "I feel I learned a lot just by listening to what he had to say, and he also showed me how to execute."

Carter also conveyed how impressed he was with Andy's genuine interest in him. **"He even** came to watch me the following day when I was running on the track with Chin, and dropped by my trailer to let me know of his observations."



## Calibration and Certification Service (This story is not about Jim!)

I've been asked several times by club members about a rumored speeding ticket I received on the return trip from LaCrosse. It is a rumor, what actually occurred is that I had my speedometer calibrated and certified by an official officer of the MN. Dept of Motor Vehicles. Here's how it works. You select the speed you want certified, set your cruise and drive on I-90 (E or W bound), appointments are not necessary, MN.D.M.V. makes a random selection of the speedometers to be calibrated and there is no guarantee that you will be selected, so you may have to make several trips.


I was traveling west when I was selected for certification and the officer was traveling east. He appeared to be very excited about delivering my certification, so enthused that he drove off the east bound lane, through the median, and on to the west bound lane, at a speed great enough to tear up a little sod that was still hanging from his front bumper when I pulled to the side of the road. He was nicely dressed in a uniform including a tie and a hat. He made an official presentation of my certificate, signed it and had me sign it too. He explained the charge for this service is based on a floating scale based on the speed I selected. He also explained that an additional service is rendered at no additional charge. He said that my certification would be posted on a web site, so that insurance companies all over the U.S. have the knowledge that my speedometer has been calibrated and certified. This information is also available to officers in other states, to be used for certification events. The presentation ceremony is much like winning a large jackpot at a casino. There were lights blinking and sirens blaring. Passing motorists shared the excitement by slowing down to watch, smile, and point. (Some even honked) It sure gets your adrenaline flowing.

I think I'll write to GM and tell them they do an excellent job of calibrating speedometers. The speed shown on my heads-up display matched the speed listed on my certification form exactly.






